Eye Mask Grading Rubric

| 1. | <p><u>Preparing and Cutting the Fabric</u> The fabric was properly pressed properly. The pattern markings were transferred to the fabric in the appropriate places. The fusible fleece was ironed to the wrong side of the fabric before sewing.</p> | 0 1 2 3 4 5 | 0 1 2 3 4 5 |
| 2. | <p><u>Eye Mask</u> The eye mask was sewn correctly. The stitching is even and straight. The curved areas are sewn smoothly according to the correct seam allowance. The curved areas were clipped or notched so that the curves lie flat on the right side. The eye mask has been pressed with the seams on the edge. The topstitching is done at 1/8" from the edge all around the eye mask.</p> | 0 1 2 3 4 5 | 0 1 2 3 4 5 |
| 3. | <p><u>Elastic Strap</u> The strap was sewn correctly using a 1/4" seam allowance. The elastic fits into the strap casing. The casing is the correct size: not too big or too small. The elastic is correctly sewn to the strap and the strap is correctly and securely sewn into the openings of the eye mask. The strap is not twisted. The fabric around the elastic is evenly gathered.</p> | 0 1 2 3 4 5 | 0 1 2 3 4 5 |
| 4. | <p><u>Neatness/Organization</u> All threads clipped, project has been pressed, seam lines are sewn straight, instructions were followed, backstitching where appropriate, directional fabric going right way, transfer markings were removed from fabric, etc.</p> | 0 1 2 3 4 5 | 0 1 2 3 4 5 |
