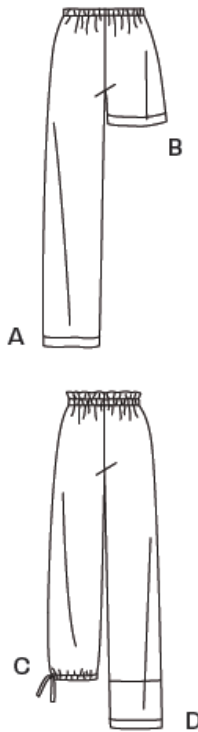

Pajamas: Pants/Capris/Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Woven cotton or flannel fabric <i>(See sizing chart on reverse side for fabric amounts.)</i>• 1 package of 1-inch wide elastic <i>(Leftovers will be used for other projects.)</i>• Coordinating All-Purpose Thread (Optional)	Monday, March 4 th
Square Zipper Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1/2-yard woven cotton fabric• 16-inch all-purpose zipper <i>(Zipper can be longer than 16 inches, but not shorter.)</i>• Coordinating All-Purpose Thread (Optional)	Thursday, March 21 st
Knit Fabric Neck Pillow & Eye Mask	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1/2-yard knit fabric• 16-18 inches of 1” wide elastic <i>(Use leftovers from Pajamas Project)</i>• Coordinating All-Purpose Thread (Optional)	Tuesday, April 2 nd

Quillow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 yards woven cotton fabric (2 yards for the top and 2 yards for the bottom) • 1 pkg. crib sized batting (45" x 60") • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Hand Embroidered Pillow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1/2 yard woven cotton fabric • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Tall Zipper Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1/2 yard woven cotton fabric • 16-inch all-purpose zipper (<i>Zipper can be longer than 16 inches, but not shorter.</i>) • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Lined Purse (Square Bottom) or Double Sided Purse (Round Bottom)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 yard woven cotton fabric (1/2 yard for inside and 1/2 yard for outside) • 2 Buttons • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Snap Top Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1/3 yard woven cotton fabric for bag front • 1/3 yard woven cotton fabric for bag lining • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Men's Neck Tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5/8 yard main fabric • 5/8 yard lining fabric • 1 yard lightweight fusible interfacing • Coordinating all-purpose thread
Small Duffel Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 1/2 yards non-directional woven cotton fabric for bag • 1/4 yard non-directional woven cotton fabric for straps • 16 inch all-purpose zipper • Coordinating all-purpose thread • Optional: 2 1/2 yard webbing (1-inch wide) in place of strap fabric
Large Duffel Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 yards non-directional woven cotton fabric for bag • 1/2 yard non-directional woven cotton fabric for straps • 20 inch all-purpose zipper • Coordinating all-purpose thread • Optional: 2 1/2 yard webbing (2-inch wide) in place of strap fabric
