	-1 Yard Woven Cotton Fabric	-Main Fabric: 3/4 (27 inches) Yard Woven Cotton Fabric -Trim Fabric: 1/8 (4.5 inches) Yard Woven Cotton Fabric -Cuff Fabric: 1/3 (12 inches) Yard Woven Cotton Fabric
Double Sided Apron	-1 1/2 Yards Fabric OR -3/4 Yard Fabric for Front AND 3/4 Yard Fabric for Back	
All Supplies/ Materials Due By:	<u>A-Day: Wednesday, January 29th</u> <u>B-Day: Thursday, January 30th</u>	

* The best fabric to buy is woven cotton. Please DO NOT BUY fleece, minky, silky fabrics, fabrics that shed when cut, or other fabrics that are difficult for beginners to sew on.
