## Thread Saver Pouch

1.	<p><b><u>Cutting Out the Pattern Pieces and Following Pattern Markings</u></b>            All pattern pieces were cut out correctly according to the grainline and pattern direction. All markings were transferred to the appropriate place on the fabric and washed out after the project was complete if necessary.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
2.	<p><b><u>5/8" Seam Allowance and Backstitching</u></b>            The pouch was sewn using a 5/8" seam allowance. The stitching is straight and even. The backstitching is secure. The pouch is sewn with the fabric right sides together.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
3.	<p><b><u>Serging and Clipped Corners</u></b>            The seam allowance of the pouch has been correctly serged. The serging is straight and even. The serging does not go over the straight stitching on the pouch. The serging thread tails have been trimmed away. The corners of the pouch have been clipped to reduce bulk. The clipping does not go through the straight stitching and there are no holes in the corners.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
4.	<p><b><u>Pressing and Topstitching</u></b>            The pouch has been turned right side out. The corners have been pushed into sharp points. There are no holes in the corners. The opening between the markings has been folded in and is straight and even. The seams have been pressed flat and even along the outer edges of the pouch. The topstitching is done using a 1/4" seam allowance. The stitching is straight and even along the bottom edge and around each edge of the pouch. The stitching was correctly pivoted at each corner. The stitching is secured with backstitching.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
5.	<p><b><u>Buttonhole</u></b>            The buttonhole has been correctly measuring using the buttonhole formula. The stitching of the button hole is done correctly and neatly. The buttonhole has been cut open correctly and is not cut too far past the ends of the buttonhole. The buttonhole is centered in the middle of the pouch flap. The buttonhole foot was used to sew the buttonhole.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
6.	<p><b><u>Button with Thread Shank</u></b>            The button has been correctly sewn to the pouch with a thread shank. The thread is not loose and the button is secure. The button is centered with the buttonhole. The thread tail is securely hidden between the two layers of the pouch fabric. The flap of the pouch does not stretch or bunch around the button.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
7.	<p><b><u>Neatness/Organization</u></b>            All threads clipped, project has been pressed, seam lines are sewn straight, instructions were followed, backstitching where appropriate, transfer markings were removed from fabric, etc.</p>	0 1 2 3 4 5	0 1 2 3 4 5
