

# Shape in Fashion



### <u>Shape</u>

- The shape, or <u>silhouette</u>, is the outline of the body/garment.
- It is one of the first things seen in the design.
- Silhouettes usually compliment the shape of the body, but exaggeration is often used to create different effects or emphasis.



#### **1. Hourglass**

- Wide top, narrow waist and wide bottom.
- Famous in:
  - **1890'**s
  - **1930'**s
  - 1950's






## **2. Rectangle/Tubular**

- Straight from shoulders to hem without a defined waistline.
- Famous in:
  - **1920'**s
  - **1960'**s
  - **1990'**s





## **3. Triangle**

- Torso and upper body are narrower than the hips.
- Famous in:
  - **1970'**s



#### **4. Inverted Triangle**

- Torso and upper body are wider than the hips.
- Famous in:
  - **1910'**s
  - **1940'**s
  - **1980'**s
