

Positive Famous Role Model Assignment

Choose to create either a Google Slideshow or an Infographic using Piktochart.

If using Google Slides:

1. Create a new Google Slides presentation in your Google Drive.
2. Be sure to share it with or email it to your teacher at: laura.schiers@washk12.org

If using Piktochart:

1. Go the following website: <http://piktochart.com/>
2. Sign in or create a new account.
3. Choose a free template.
4. When finished with the Infographic, click on the SHARE button in the upper right hand corner and share via email as a PicktoCard to laura.schiers@washk12.org
5. Be sure to include your name on the Infographic as well as in the email message.
6. Don't forget to SAVE occasionally!
7. Remember your login information in case you don't get finished in class. That way you can log back in and start from where you left off.

Requirements for the Assignment:

1. Your name and class period must be somewhere on the infographic or slideshow.
2. Identify your role model. (Who is it?)
3. Identify why your role model is famous or well known.
 - a. What are their achievements or contributions to society?
4. List or describe at least 10 positive characteristics of your role model.
5. Provide at least 5 appropriate pictures of your role model.

BONUS!

For 10 extra credit points:

1. Choose a positive role model that you know personally. This could be a parent, coach, friend, sibling, teacher, religious leader, etc.
2. Write one paragraph (5 complete sentences) about why this person is your role model. What is it about them that you admire or look up to? What makes them a positive role model to you and others?
3. Email this paragraph to: laura.schiers@washk12.org
4. In the subject of the email, include:
 - a. Your Name (First and Last)-Class Period-Extra Credit
